Graduation Participation at John Paul II:

In order to participate in the Commencement Exercises at John Paul II students must:

- 1. Be enrolled at John Paul II Catholic High School during the present year;
- 2. Have 90% attendance and punctuality (no more than 10 absences and 10 lates).
- 2. Have successfully completed Religion 35 or must be enrolled and passing the course at midterm in semester II;
- 3. Have met all Alberta High School Diploma Requirements as outlined above;
- 4. Have paid all outstanding fees prior to being placed on the Grad list.

- 5. Be on track to complete their high school diploma by the end of June in their graduation year.6. Complete at least 20 credits at St. John Paul II in his/her graduating year.
- 7. *The official graduation list* will be following the first reporting period of semester II.
