- Continue to explore programs such as High School Flexibility and Dual-Credit options with the goal of providing the best learning opportunities for our students.
- Support PD opportunities that meet the individual goals of staff, the school district, and Alberta Education.
- As we continue to grow, we will ensure each staff member is utilized in a manner that best leverages his/her strengths while hiring new staff who will bring new and varied skills to our school.
