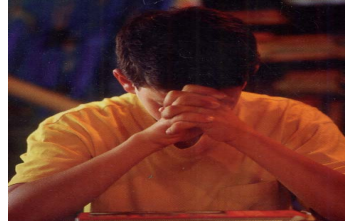

### School Goals and Provincial Goals:

86% of our stakeholders reported being generally satisfied with the Catholic culture at St. JP II  
85% of our stakeholders reported being generally satisfied with the integration of Catholic values at St. JP II

- On PAT exams, the number of students reaching the acceptable standard increased by about 5% from the previous year and about 4% from the three year average.
- On Diploma exams, the number of students reaching the acceptable standard increased by about 2% from the previous year and about 6% from the three year average.
- Our Drop Out Rate decreased a further 1.5% from our three year average and 3% from the year before.
- We are appealing to all learners by preparing students to enter all fields of work. 24% of our students plan to enter the trades; 6% above the national average.
- Staff believe they are encouraged in their development
- Staff participated in 4 TLC collaboration meetings throughout the year.
- Instituted an Allocations Committee
- Developed an effective RTI model
- Two staff members participated in EXCEL

### Characteristics of our Catholic Faith in Action:

### Relationships:

- St. John Paul II believes that parents have an important role to play in their Children's Education and we invite parents to communicate with teachers on a regular basis.
- Teachers work hard to build relationships with students through regular classroom experiences and a strong extra-curricular program. 79% of our students report having positive relationships with staff members – this is higher than the Canadian average.
- Our staff believes that building community must begin at the staff level. Our annual staff retreat and weekly prayer experiences are designed to build community and strengthen the bond that exists between staff members.

### Inclusive Learning – Our Response to Intervention:

Our goal is to ensure that high quality learning opportunities exist for every student, tailored to meet their individual needs. Our RTI meets weekly to review students who are experiencing difficulty and to ensure that they have the supports in place for success.

### Student Engagement:

Our staff is committed to creating learning experiences where students are engaged thinkers and active learners. Professional Development experiences have targeted Assessment for Learning, Differentiating Instruction and Technology Integration. Our High School Coordinators lead the charge in terms of Instructional Improvement.
